



## BlendEd Basics

BlendEd learning refers to best practices associated with enhancing a face-to-face classroom with online activities. The goal is to leverage the technology to better personalize the learning experience through more effective differentiation in small group instruction, empower learners by slowly scaffolding control to students over learning processes (example: choice in learning tasks), promote mastery learning through adaptive learning platforms (example: Khan Academy, IXL, Study Island), and engage students in deeper learning through the creation of artifacts demonstrating acquisition of content area standards and digital age skills. This workshop will introduce you to BlendEd best practices through hands-on learning activities.

Participants will also gain access to an online course packed with extended resources.
