Target Audience:	This training is intended for those who will help run already established verbal behavior programs such as paraprofessionals. It can also serve as a refresher for team members who have done the full 3 day training.
Description:	<p>Students with a verbal behavior program often benefit from implementation of the programming across multiple environments and with different people. This workshop is designed for those who will be helping to run a verbal behavior program but are not responsible for the primary assessment, selection of skills to teach, or making instructional decisions based on data. In this workshop</p> <p>Participants will learn important behavioral teaching principles including what is verbal behavior, discrete trial training, reinforcement, pairing, prompting and shaping</p> <p>Participants will learn the verbal operants and why we teach a variety of skills</p> <p>Participants will learn how to use errorless teaching techniques and error correction to help improve skill acquisition</p> <p>Participants will receive hands-on instruction and practice on errorless teaching and error correction using the card sort system</p>
